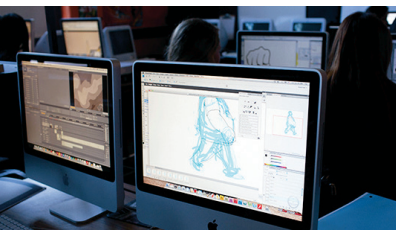
Licensing designed to fit your needs

Enrollment made easy

Primary and secondary schools may enroll in the EEA and be covered as a single school site, or multiple schools may enroll and be covered under a legal entity that has responsibility for the procurement and contract management of multiple schools (district, county, state, government agency, and so on). Enrolling schools are licensed on a per-FTE (full-time equivalent) basis and must cover the entire school or legal entity.
